



## By Public Transport

#### ▼From Korea University Station (Metro Line 6)

Take Exit 3 and turn right at first corner  $\rightarrow$  Walk straight for 350 meters until you see SK gas station  $\rightarrow$  Cross the street and walk into the KIST/GKEDC Entrance  $\rightarrow$  Walk straight for 150 meters and take a right turn

#### ▼From Cheongnyangni Station (Metro Line 1/Gyeongui-Joungang Line)

Take Exit 2  $\rightarrow$  Take Bus 201 or 1226 at Hyundai Core Station  $\rightarrow$  Get off at King Sejong the Great Memorial Hall (3 stops)  $\rightarrow$  Cross the street and walk into the KIST/GKEDC Entrance  $\rightarrow$  Walk straight for 150 meters and take a right turn

## ▼From Korea University Station to GKEDC

Route: Korea University Station (Exit 3)  $\rightarrow$  KIST/National Institute of Forest Science Entrance  $\rightarrow$  GKEDC Departs from Korea University Station every 30 minutes, 10:00 AM-11:30 AM and 1:00 PM-4:30 PM

## ■ From GKEDC to Korea University Station

Route: GKEDC → Korea University Station

Departs from GKEDC every 30 minutes, 10:20 AM-11:50 AM and 1:20 PM-5:20 PM
